HANSON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS Tuesday, November 25, 2025

Commissioner Kjetland called the Hanson County Drainage meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 25, 2025 with members Bumgardner, Fox, and Waldera present. Schoenrock was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion Fox, seconded by Waldera to approve the agenda after adding Citizen Input. Motion carried.

Motion Bumgardner, seconded by Waldera to approve the drainage minutes from October 28th. Motion carried.

Conflicts, none.

Wayne Waldner joined to ask if a drainage permit is needed to fill in a dugout in section 13-103-59. As the dugout is in a blue line, a permit will be needed but further clarification of the County's ordinance will be reviewed and discussed with Drainage Administrator Roth and the States Attorney.

The filed drainage complaint was reviewed, motion Fox, seconded by Waldera to set a hearing date for January 6, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. unless the drainage issue is resolved prior to then. The States Attorney will send notification to all parties involved.

After reviewing the permit and checklist attached, motion Bumgardner, seconded by Fox to approve permit #25-70 for Dennis Brakke to clean ditch and remove trees in section 8-103-59. Work to be done by Bob Bannwarth. All members voted aye, motion carried.

After reviewing the permit and checklist attached, motion Bumgardner, seconded by Fox to approve permit #25-69 for John Heinz to do drainage ditch work in the SE4 of 19-101-57. Work to be done by Danny Roth. All members voted aye, motion carried.

After reviewing the permit and checklist attached, motion Fox, seconded by Bumgardner to approve permit #25-68 for New Elm Springs to tile part of the S2 of 19-101-57. Waldera abstained, all others voted aye, motion carried.

As there was no further business before the Board, a motion was made by Waldera, seconded by Bumgardner to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
